THAT QUENCHES THIRST

DID YOU KNOW that a significant 69% of fresh water on Earth is locked in glaciers? It takes a staggering 6,800 gallons to grow a day's food for a family of four. Tragically, 780 million people lack access to an improved water source. In a single day, women worldwide spend 200 million hours collecting water for their families. In some countries, less than half the population has access to water¹.

Every week, a young girl named Barbara accompanied her grandfather, Luis², on horseback to gather water from a muddy pool. Barbara is being ministered to by ACTION workers. Life in Northeastern Brazil is not for the faint-hearted. Much of Brazil's vast northeast is, in effect, turning into a desert, a process called desertification worsening across the planet. The region had its longest drought from 2012 through 2017; this year will be no different.

ACTION came to Luis's rescue. The local church had drilled three wells, but all went south and were dry. A well was drilled on donated land. Eureka! Water gushed to the joy of the local communities. It is providing a solution to the water crisis.

ACTION Brazil prays for not only physical water but also a revival in this drought-prone place. What is a revival? Revival is the restoration of spiritual vigor. It refers to reawakening the path of God's love from stagnancy.



Jesus said, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water." (John 7:37-38) The living water is the Holy Spirit. The Spirit gives life. Just as water refreshes and revitalizes a thirsty person, the spirit gives life to the believer, enabling God to produce fruit. Barbara is a true example of having physical and spiritual water, showing her community that Jesus is active in her life.
